

NO FICA ION FOR ACCESING P BLIC BENEFIT S OR INS RANCE

Upon receipt of parental consent, the [LEA] will submit claims to the Virginia Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS), (including the release information about our child's participation in services of participating physicians, other health care providers, DMAS, and DMAS billing agency, and an [LEA] billing agency as necessary, to process claims for reimbursement by DMAS) for covered health-related services, e.g. all charges for these services and transportation, on the date the dependent received a health-related service which are outlined in the child's Individualized Education Program (IEP), including duration and frequency and/or e.g. all charges for IEP services.

The [LEA] will accept our or our child's public benefits or insurance copayments for services in our child's IEP.

With regard to services required to provide a free appropriate public education (FAPE) to our child, the LEA may not:

- Require our or our child to enroll in public benefits or insurance programs in order for our child to receive FAPE.
- Require our or our child to pay out-of-pocket expenses, such as the payment of a deductible or copayment in filing a claim for services, although the [LEA] may pay the cost of our or our child's health insurance.
- Use our child's benefits if he/she would (i) decrease available life expectancy or another insured benefit; (ii) result in our family paying for services he/she would otherwise be covered by the public benefits or insurance program and he/she are required for our child outside of the time our child is in school; (iii) increase premiums or lead to the discontinuation of benefits or insurance; or (iv) risk loss of eligibility for home and community-based services, based on aggregate health-related expenditures.

You have the right to withdraw our consent or disclosure of our child's personally identifiable information to the parties listed above at any time.

Your withdrawal of consent or our refusal to provide consent or disclosure of our child's personally identifiable information to the parties listed above does not relieve the [LEA] of its responsibility to ensure that all required services are provided at no cost to us.
