

NO IFICA ION FOR ACCESSING PUBLIC BENEFITS OR INSURANCE

Upon receipt of parental consent, the [LEA] will file claims on behalf of the Virginia Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS), including the release of information about our child's participation in services or participating physicians, other health care providers, DMAS, and DMAS billing agents, and an [LEA] billing agent as necessary, to process claims for reimbursement by DMAS for covered health-related services, including those for home services and transportation, on behalf of the individual receiving a health-related service which are outlined in the child's Individualized Education Program (IEP), including direction and frequency and/or duration for IEP services.

The [LEA] will access or provide or child's public benefits or insurance on behalf of services in our child's IEP.

With regard to services required to provide a free appropriate public education (FAPE) to our child, the LEA may do:

- Request or assign or enroll in public benefits or insurance programs in order for our child to receive FAPE.
- Request or increase or-of-pocket expenses, such as the payment of a deductible or copayment in filing a claim for services, although the [LEA] may pay the cost to another service provider requested on behalf of our child.
- Use our child's benefits if they have (i) decreased available life insurance or another individual benefit; (ii) result in our family paying for services having other benefits covered by the public benefits or insurance program and have requested for our child outside of the time our child is in school; (iii) increased premiums or lead to the discontinuation of benefits or insurance; or (iv) risk losses of eligibility for home and community-based services, based on aggregate health-related expenditures.

You have the right to withhold our consent to disclosure of our child's personally identifiable information to the parties listed above at any time.

You may withhold our refusal to provide consent to disclosure of our child's personally identifiable information to the parties listed above does not relieve the [LEA] of its responsibility to ensure that all requested services are provided at no cost to us.
